## **MAIN ATTRACTIONS**

- Tour of the City of Ottawa (by Grey Line Bus-check with your hotel)
- Parliament Hill (1 Wellington Street) (Senate, House of Commons, Library)
- Rideau Hall (1 Sussex Drive) (Official residence of the Governor General-partially opened to the public)
- Embassy Row (Embassies and exclusive homes--behind Rideau Hall-Range Road, Wilbrod Street, parts of Laurier Ave. and Charlotte Ave)
- National Gallery of Canada (380 Sussex) (Art Museum-permanent collection & temporary exhibits)
- Notre-Dame Basilica (385 Sussex) (Neo-Gothic cathedral built in the mid-1800s)
- Canada Science and Technology Museum (1867 St Laurent Blvd) (largest museum of its kind in Canada)
- Canadian War Museum (1, Vimy Place) (Mandate: to advance the study of Canada's military history)
- Canadian Museum of Civilization (100 Laurier Street, Gatineau) (includes the Canadian Children's Museum & The Canadian Postal Museum) (Journey across Canada covering 1,000 years of Canadian history; cultural heritage of the Native Peoples of Canada's West Coast)
- Laurier House (335 Laurier Ave East) (home predates the current official residence of the Prime Minister)
- Byward Market area (north of Rideau Street & East of Sussex Drive -12 square blocks-near Château Laurier and also the National Art Gallery) (shopping & restaurant district)
- Skating on the Rideau Canal, the world's largest skating rink (7.8km)-annually in February
- Tulip Festival-annually in May
